

# "Modern" Masterpiece

You will create a new masterpiece by combining your portrait into an existing masterpiece. Search for a portrait painting completed by a master painter such as Da Vinci, Picasso, Frida Kahlo, Norman Rockwell... Once you are happy with the masterpiece you want to work with you will need to have your picture taken in the same position. You must also include 3 other items in the scene that will help make the masterpiece "your self portrait". Examples of "other items": jewelry, items on wall/floor, pictures, hobby/interests...

## Image Requirements:

- 1) Image should be 8.5" x 11" (Letter), or 11" x 8.5"
- 2) Resolution: 300 ppi
- 3) Color Mode: RGB
- 4) Background: White

- 1) The masterpiece will be your "background" image. Drag entire image onto your work space. Stretch your image proportionally to fit across your work space.
- 2) Use magic wand or lasso tool to select the area of your portrait that you want to move. Drag selection onto your work space.
- 3) The two images should seamlessly blend together. Use eraser to blend edges of images together. Repair empty area with the clone or pattern stamp.
- 4) Flatten image, and save as a pdf in the "To be graded" file. Save as: Last Name\_Title

Steps: File > Print > Scroll to Adobe PDF > Properties (page size: letter, default setting: high quality, OK) > OK

(select your folder first, and save a copy in the "To be Graded" as well)
